4. Letter of recommendation
5. Applicant statement and consent
6. Logos and photos

- Description of the project's product or service as planned and as delivered
- Sustainability challenges and how they were addressed
- Actual sustainability impacts (if known)
- Planned and actual costs, resources, and milestones

4. Letter of Recommendation

Include a letter of recommendation from the faculty member who sponsored the research (for students) or from your direct supervisor or project sponsor (for professionals).

5. Applicant Statement and Consent

I, the undersigned applicant, confirm that all information provided in this application is true and correct, and that the submitted research or project description is my own original work.

I agree to observe the rules of the GPM Global Sustainability Awards and accept the decisions of the judging panel as final.
